Introduction to Line Dancing with Janice - January 24 and February 21, 10am-11:30am in the hall. Admission \$10.

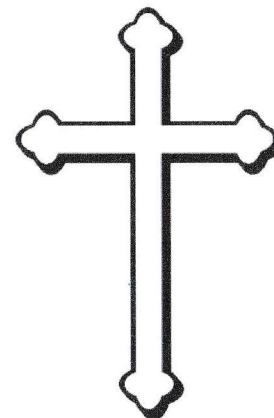
