Messy Church has been postponed to Saturday, March 16.

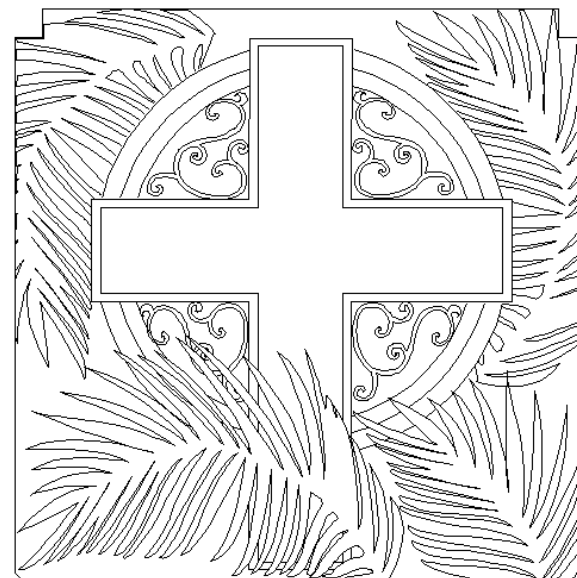
