Introduction to Line Dancing with Janice - February 21, at 10am-11:30am in the hall. Admission \$10. Snacks and water will be sold.

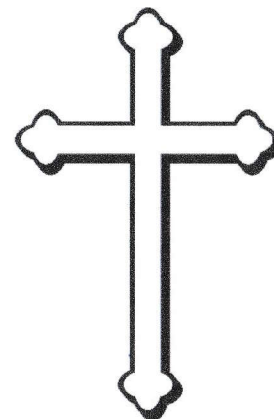
