If you would like a paper copy of the AGM Report, please put your name on the Sign Up Sheet in the Narthex. An electronic version of the report will also be available.


**Introduction to Line Dancing** with Janice - February 21, at 10am-11:30am in the hall. Admission \$10. Snacks and water will be sold.
