Fundscip- the next order date is November 17th. This is the last order before Christmas.

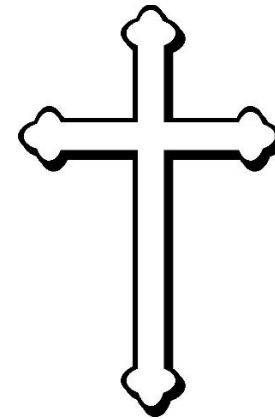
