**Fundscrip:** Don't forget to pick up your gift cards from Cécile or Treena.

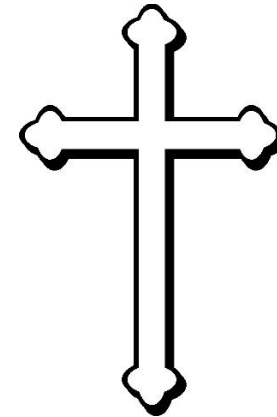
