Fundscrip- the next Fundscrip order date is February 9th. Please give your order to Cecile or Treena on or before that date.

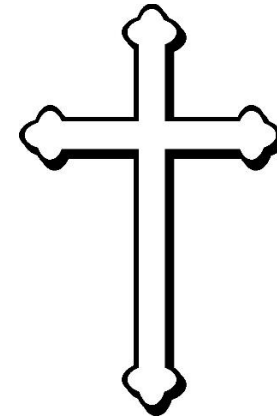
