You do not have to submit your financial statements now. Those will be needed for the Financial Review at a later date.

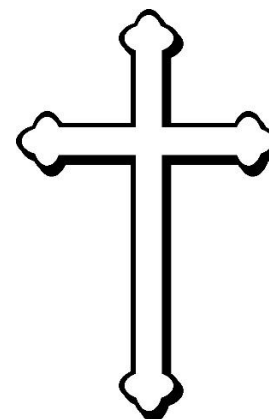
