PWRDF: We have set a goal of raising \$1000 for the PWRDF during Lent this year. So far we have raised \$405. Good work and keep it up!

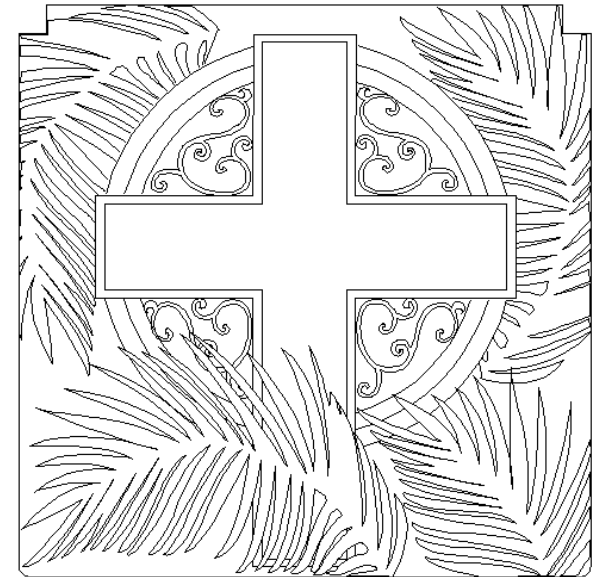
